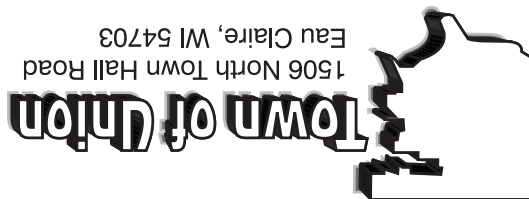
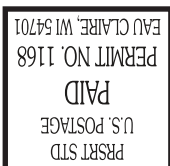

# Important Information...

**Elections:** There are no fall elections in 2025

**Town Hall Rentals:** The Union Town Hall is available to rent by Town Residents Only. The cost is \$150/day with a deposit of \$200. Please contact the Town Clerk at 715-874-6123 to reserve your date. Overnight parking is prohibited in the Town of Union parking lot.

**Tax Payments & dates:** Will be posted on the Town of Union Website [www.townofunionec.com](http://www.townofunionec.com) and in the property tax bill. Dates will be Dec 22, 24, 29, 31 - 5:30-8:30pm, Dec 20, 27 9am-1pm, Jan 19, 21, 26, 28, - 5:30-8:30pm, Jan 24, 31 9am-1pm

**Dog Licenses:** If you own a dog 5 months of age or older, Wisconsin State Law requires dogs to be licensed yearly. Please refer to the Town website [townofunionec.com](http://townofunionec.com) for more information or refer to your property tax bill for your dog license application.

**Building Permits** are required by the Town of Union through Eau Claire County. Please contact EC CTY Building Inspector Fred Dahlke at (715)839-2944.

**Road Right of Way (ROW):** If you mow your property's ditch or ROW, Thank You. The Town contracts with EC CTY HWY Dept. and Union Fire Department to maintain our ROW mowing. Fall mowing is underway. Please refrain from any planting, irrigation, landscaping, fencing, etc. as it is prohibited. Though the season is coming to an end, please DO NOT mow grass clipping into the roadway.

**Driveway Permits** are required. The cost is \$25. If a culvert is required, you must meet Wisconsin Department of Transportation standards. Contact Chris Turner at (715)829-3737 for more information.

**Township Fire Department (TFD)** Is recruiting! If you are ready to serve your community join the Township Fire Department or Emergicare. Contact Town of Union Battalion Chief Eddie Yates at 952-224-6291 or Chief Kerry Parker at 715-577-2010.

**Burning Permits:** If you plan to burn, you must obtain a burning permit. Burning permits are only available online, visit [townshipfire.org](http://townshipfire.org) to fill out your permit application and stay informed of DNR burn bans.

**Transfer Station:** The Town of Union is hiring a part-time Transfer Station attendant to periodically fill in for the current attendant. Hours of operation are every other Wednesday (1-5:30) and Saturday (9-5:30) pay is \$15/hr. Position is available Jan. 1, 2025. Please contact Chair Jennifer Meyer @ (715)456-5903.
